MATH TIME STRATEGY!

LEARN HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE NUMBER PATTERN ABOVE.

Hint: 3 = 1 + 2 (starting number is 1, add 2 to make 3), 6 = 3 + 3 (starting number is 3, add 3 to make 6), 10 = 6 + 4 (starting number is 6, add 4 to make 10), 15 = 10 + 5 (starting number is 10, add 5 to make 15)

New numbers will be 15 + 6 = 21, 21 + 7 = 28, 28 + 8 = 36, 36 + 9 = 45
